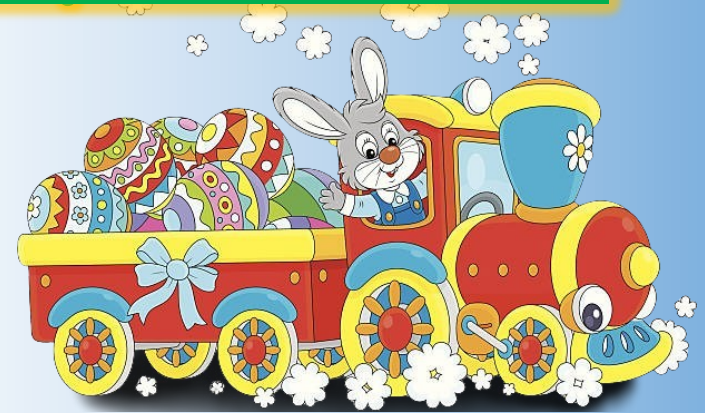

We are located inside the middle entrance of the Still Water Industrial Park (former Simpson Sort Yard/Mill 5).

We are Off of Shelton Matlock Rd. approx. mile post 10

Note– we are not off of Hanks lake road or near the Vance Creek Rail riders.

The depot is next to the historic log car

When we are operating signs direct you to the parking area.

From 101 go west on Shelton Matlock Rd approximately 9 miles (mile post 10)

From Matlock travel east on Shelton Matlock Rd about 2 miles past Lake Nahwatzel
